Our history

In October 1951 five women met to discuss the possibility of forming an association and of starting a training program for their children with an intellectual disability and others in the area. In March 1952 the Sunnyfield Association was formed. In 1957 a Hostel was built and opened at Allambie Heights for 27 people with disability. Over the next two decades more houses were built and Sunnyfield expanded out of Sydney's Northern Beaches, to provide Shared Living, Community Support and Employment Services.

Today, Sunnyfield provides support for nearly 2000 people with disability with over 1200 staff in New South Wales and ACT.
